In PSED this half term we will be covering: Showing more confidence in new social situations Finding solutions to conflict and rivalries Remembering rules without needing an adult to remind them Talking with others to solve conflicts. Understanding gradually how others might be feeling. We will do this through discussion, stories, visits and role play. Phonics

This half term we will be continuing our teaching of 'Foundations for phonics'. We will look at the progression of sounds of v w y z qu and ch.

We will teach children to identify initial sounds of words and names of objects and teach the children to distinguish different sounds.

We teach phonics using Little Wandle. You will find more information about Little Wandle on the Little Wandle website, where there are videos demonstrating how to pronounce the sounds: <u>https://www.littlewandlelettersandsounds.org.uk/</u>

Maths

This half term we are continuing to teach maths. The areas we are covering are:

- Beginning to recognise some numbers above 5
- Solving real world mathematical problems with numbers up to 5.
- Describing a familiar route. Discuss routes and locations, using words such as `in front' and `behind'.
- Make comparisons between objects relating to size, length, weight and capacity
- Extending and creating ABAB patterns. Notice and correct an error in a repeating pattern.
- Beginning to describe a sequence of events, real or fictional, using words such as 'first', 'then'
